

Our Young Children's Classes are designed to allow young children to explore movement through music, develop physical skills, channel energy, and stimulate imagination and creativity. Dance training enhances cognitive learning skills such as memory and communication.

The emphasis for each class is to learn good clean technique, improve strength and flexibility, and build a vocabulary of steps. Students are expected to work hard and challenge themselves to improve.

Students can choose from a variety of classes in different styles of dance. Age 9-16 level classes offer a End of the Year performance in June - students that register for the spring semester by March 1st with good attendance will be invited to participate.

## ENROLLMENT, PAYMENTS AND TUITION

**Tuition: \$381 (full 20 wks);** if enrolled in two or more classes, Automated Installment Options available (fee incurs) in direct debit or credit card payment. Separate installment form must be submitted with registration form.

**Tuition is not refundable** (unless the Center cancels a class or workshop). BalletNova Center for Dance is a 501(c) (3) non-profit organization and cannot provide refunds. **If a student decides to voluntarily drop out of a class, they are still responsible for the full tuition.**

**Enrollment:** Enrollment for classes is on a first-come, first-served basis. Class sizes are limited; register early to ensure desired class time. New students are accepted throughout the semester on a prorated basis.

**Attendance/Punctuality:** Students who are more than 10 minutes late will be asked to return for a makeup on another day, or take a later class (missing the initial warm-up can contribute to injury; latecomers also disrupt the class for the teacher and other students). If a dancer is going to be absent you should call or email the studio to excuse the child. Dancers can take a makeup class in an equivalent or lower level class. Make-ups cannot be taken during observation classes in January and June (contact the studio for schedule information during those months). Make ups are not available between family members and must be taken within the same semester.

**Etiquette:** Dancers will show respect and courtesy for all students, teachers and staff members. Disruptive and improper behavior will not be tolerated – neither will bullying, negative, derogatory comments, or overblown egos. At BalletNova, we all support and encourage each other. Parents are requested to sit in the community room during class, and not in the hallways. Children under the age of 15 are not allowed to sit in the studio during an adult class. If children cannot quietly (as determined by the instructor) sit in the hallway or in the waiting room parents need to make babysitting arrangements for them outside of the studio premises
